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# MEASURE GUIDE

- Begin by creating an overview sketch of your living room layout. Label the cardinal directions (north, south, east, west) to understand how natural light enters the room.
- Next, measure each wall's length, starting from one corner to the other. Don't forget to record ceiling heights, as they can impact lighting and decor choices.
- Moving on to doors and windows, measure their dimensions meticulously. Include the width, height, and depth of doorways and windows. This information will be crucial for choosing new fixtures or treatments.
- Make note of any special features like built-in bookshelves or fireplace mantels, recording their dimensions and positions in the room.
- Take a moment to identify any obstructions that might affect your renovation plans. These could be radiators, columns, or structural elements. Record their measurements and note their locations.
- Calculating the square footage of your living room is essential for flooring decisions. Measure the entire floor area, subtracting any alcoves or areas that won't be part of the new design. This square footage will guide you when purchasing flooring materials.
- Detail is key in this guide. Identify the positions of electrical outlets, switches, and fixtures. This information will help you plan lighting and electronics placement effectively. Additionally, measure the height from the floor to these outlets.
- If you have furniture you plan to keep, record its dimensions. This includes the length, width, and height of sofas, coffee tables, and any other pieces you want to incorporate into the renovated space.
- While taking measurements, snap some photos to provide visual references during the renovation process. This can be especially helpful when choosing colors, textures, and arranging furniture.
- Lastly, check that your walls are plumb (perfectly vertical) and level (perfectly horizontal). Note the materials used for your walls, whether it's drywall, plaster, or something else.
